## Trees Versus Pipes

Trees provide pleasant shade around the home and are friendly to our environment, but tree roots can create havoc with the underground sewer system.

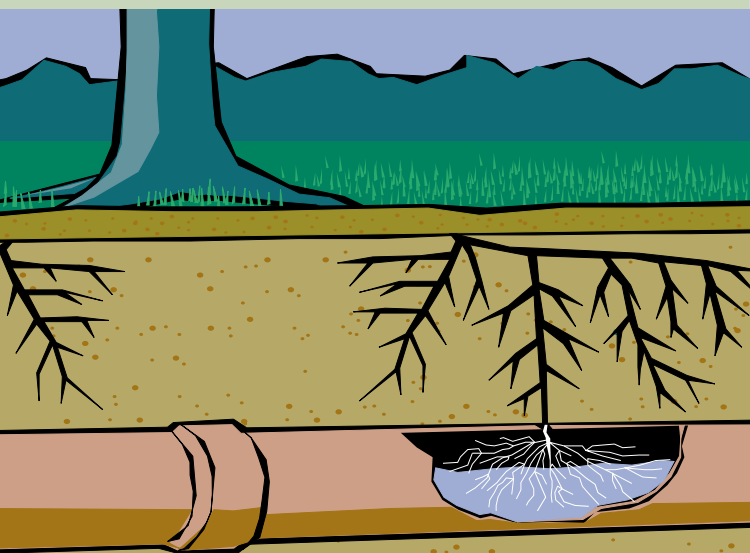
Tree roots are currently responsible for the majority of Melbourne's sewer and drain blockages. These problems are most common in household properties. For example, roots of poplar trees have been found in pipes more than 30 metres beyond the tree base and like other 'problem species' such as willows, figs, rubber trees and large eucalypts, they can also damage buildings, footpaths, fences and pipes.

With new design standards allowing sewers to be constructed at a shallower depth, the risk of tree root infiltration is increasing. However, it is a problem which can be avoided if care is taken when selecting trees and deciding where to plant them.

## A Costly Problem

Few people realise just how aggressive tree roots can be in their endless search for moisture and nutrients. Your property sewer pipes are a prime target, and if there's the slightest way in through the smallest fracture, the tree roots will find it.

Once in the system, hair-like roots may grow into a fibrous mass, spreading long distances within the pipe, reducing flow and eventually causing blockages and pipe damage. As well as being inconvenient, this problem can be costly. Property owners are responsible for maintaining all plumbing fixtures up to the connection with South East Water's sewer branch, which is usually inside the property boundary. Only licensed plumbers are permitted to work on sewer pipes.

If a tree is identified as causing a blockage to one of South East Water's sewer mains, you can elect to have us remove the offending tree at no cost to you.

### *Prevention is Better than the Cure*

It is better for everyone involved to prevent the problem rather than treat the damage as it occurs. Before you plant trees, make sure you know where the sewer pipes on your property are located.

To find out where your property sewer pipes are located, you can obtain a Property Sewerage Plan from South East Water by calling **131 694** or visiting our customer service centre at **20 Corporate Drive, Moorabbin**. There is a charge for this service. The Property Sewerage Plan details the type and location of sewer pipes on your property, and with this information you can avoid planting new trees or shrubs over or near your sewer pipes.

When selecting trees, visit your local nursery for advice. They will assist you in choosing the appropriate trees or shrubs for your garden, and more importantly those trees you should avoid planting near pipes. Although there are no hard and fast rules, there are however, certain problem species that require particular care when deciding where to plant.

### *Planting in Nature Strips*

If you would like to plant trees in your nature strip you should first gain permission from your local council and then contact South East Water to ascertain the location of the sewer and water mains and drainage pipes. You will also need to consider hazardous situations such as overhead powerlines, taking into account the size of the tree when it reaches full maturity. Blind spots near driveways are also another hazardous situation and you should also consider your neighbours' buildings, paving and drains when planting.
